Rev. Joel Kim is an ordained minister in the Presbyterian Church in America, and has taught New Testament at Westminster Seminary California since 2005 and in 2017 was appointed as the fourth president of WSC. He previously taught at Calvin Theological Seminary and International Theological Seminary in Los Angeles, as well as in Taiwan and Indonesia. When he was nine years of age, he and his family moved from South Korea to Southern California, where he would learn English and retain fluency in Korean.

Among other publications, he co-edited *Always Reformed: Essays in Honor of W. Robert Godfrey* (Westminster Seminary California, 2012). Rev. Kim's doctoral studies in historical theology were with the noted scholar Professor Richard A. Muller at Calvin Theological Seminary.

Rev. Kim and his wife, Sharon, have a daughter and a son; the family resides in Escondido and attends New Life Presbyterian Church.
